
In continuation to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 3.8.2004 on the above subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government to renew its permission for 2nd year BDS Course with an annual admission capacity of 60 students in K.S.R. Institute of Dental Sciences & Research at Thokkavadi, Tiruchengode, Dist. Namakkal, Tamil Nadu, for the academic session 2005-2006.

2. This permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of students during the academic session 2005-06. Further, the admissions should be made strictly in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Government of India on 14.5.2003 in pursuance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Madhu Singh Case.

3. The Central Government permission will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of the annual targets. The next batch of students will be admitted in the College only after renewal of 3rd year permission in the college.

4. The admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.
